
# Corporate Social Responsibility Policy

# **Corporate Social Responsibility during 2016-17**

Prabhat Foundation has carried out a range of welfare programmes and spent ₹52.03 lacs towards medical, education and other assistance during the year 2016-17. The aid and assistance was extended for providing quality and accessible healthcare and educational upbringing. In support of persons suffering from mental retardation and developmental disabilities, financial aid was extended to NGOs that are engaged in the work of charity. Financial help was also given to the Trusts in the field of charity and orphanage.

#### Medical Assistance

Diverse Medical Assistance of ₹31.81 lacs were given to a range of beneficiaries.

# **Highlights of Medical Assistance:**

- 16 Cancer patients were extended help of ₹3.82 lacs
- 13 Heart patients were extended help of ₹4.55 lacs
- 6 Kidney patients were extended help of ₹1.05 lacs
- 131 patients suffering from various illnesses were extended help of ₹20.56 lacs
- Medicines worth ₹1.83 lacs were purchased and distributed among the poor and needy

# **Educational Assistance**

Towards Educational Assistance an amount of ₹16.37 lacs was contributed for upliftment of deprived students and in support of educational amenities/services/fees.

# Help provided to Govt. Higher Secondary School, Silora (Ajmer)

An amount of ₹70,000/- was given as aid to the school towards cost of furniture and building toilets for girls. Continuous financial help improved the infrastructure at this school, thereby, increasing the number of students from 215 to 490 in a span of 2 years.


Tuition fees amounting to ₹50,000/- was sponsored in June 2016, for the girls at Prem Sadan, an orphanage situated in Mumbai.



- An amount of ₹10,000/- was provided in support of Raigad Police welfare fund.
