PRABHAT FOUNDATION TRUST

Corporate Social Responsibility during 2017-18

Prabhat Foundation has carried out a range of welfare programmes and spent ₹110.28 lacs towards Medical, Education and Other Assistance during the year 2017-18. The aid and assistance was in favour of providing quality and accessible health care and educational upbringing. In support of those suffering from mental retardation and developmental disabilities, financial aid was extended to NGOs who are in this work of charity. Financial help was also given to trusts working towards charity raising and orphanages.

Medical Assistance

Diverse medical assistance of ₹33.98 lacs was given to a range of beneficiaries.

Highlights of medical assistance:

- 07 Cancer patients were extended help amounting ₹4.05 lacs
- 08 Heart patients were extended help amounting ₹1.87 lacs
- 05 Kidney patients were extended help amounting ₹1.35 lacs
- 155 patients suffering from different types of illnesses were extended help amounting ₹22.57 lacs
- Medicines worth ₹4.14 lacs were purchased and distributed among the poor and the needy.

Educational Assistance

An amount of ₹73.98 lacs was pledged towards upliftment of deprived students and in support of providing educational amenities, services and fees.

Highlights of educational assistance:

- Employees were assisted with an amount of ₹3.98 lacs for their educational purposes
- Educational sponsorship of ₹12.10 lacs was provided to 6 students who were pursuing fellowship programmes

RATLAM

Ipca Ratlam provided assistance of ₹22.65 lacs on CSR activities to aid social causes. Some of the major initiatives are:

Heathcare assistance to elderly at Ma Kankeshwari - Old-age home

At Ma Kankeshwari Old-age home, 20 - 22 senior citizens (male & female) reside there. Monthly health check-ups are held for these inmates by Ipca's CSR team along with our appointed doctors. This check up includes sugar test, blood pressure and other essential routine checks. Based on diagnosis by the medical team, required medicines are also provided to these inmates. During the year 2017-18, these session was carried out from April 2017 through August 2017. The amount pledged for this activity was ₹17,362/-

BARODA

Ipca Baroda provided assistance of ₹6.32 lacs on CSR activities to aid social causes. Some of the major initiatives are:
