Prabhat Foundation has carried out a range of welfare programmes and spent ₹88.84 lacs towards Medical, Education and Other Assistance during the year 2018-19. The aid and assistance was extended to provide quality and accessible health care which included dialysis machine to Rotary Club - Mumbai, free distribution of medicines, various materials to civil surgeon hospitals etc.

Financial aid was also extended towards educational upbringing namely, pursuing fellowship in medicine, infrastructure development of government schools and scholarships for economically backward meritorious students of professional education like Medicine and Engineering.






